

BareBarokk

The Norwegian baroque ensemble BareBarokk was founded in 2015. Its core composition consists of Øystein Thomessen (flute and traverso), Ricardo Odriozola (violin), Anne Stine Dahl (cello) and the Guy Poupart (harpsichord and organ). Performances often include other professional musicians and choirs or vocal ensembles. Depending on the circumstances and the repertoire, the ensemble plays on baroque or modern instruments. BareBarokk regularly invites renowned performers (like José Vázquez† and Viola de Hoog) to workshops for young musicians who are eager to learn about historically informed playing.

BareBarokk has had 70 performances since its founding. Their repertoire includes works of many major baroque composers (Bach, Telemann, Couperin, Marais, Handel, Vivaldi, Purcell, Buxtehude et al.) as well as some newer works (Krogseth and Martinu).

BareBarokk has received generous funds from the Norwegian state (Kulturdirektoratet) and the county administration (Vestfold / Vestfold og Telemark fylkeskommune).
